ENTER HIS GATES

• HOW TO USE THIS MONTHLY PRAYER GUIDE

There are four sections to this guide. This first one is called ENTER HIS GATES. The second is PRAYING FOR OTHERS. The third is PRAYING FOR CHRIST'S MISSION, and the last is TRACKING HIS ANSWERS. This first section highlights a teaching point and a way to chart personal growth.

• JULY TEACHING POINT:

Do you know people who live life timidly? Or maybe even if you don't normally live life hesitantly, there can be moments that fear causes worry, paralysis, delay or withdrawal. However, 2 Timothy 1:7 (NIV84) says, "For God did not give us a spirit of timidity, but a spirit of power, of love and of self-discipline." God doesn't make us timid. Jesus never lacked confidence or courage, so neither do we have to be either. In prayer we ought to be as bold as Jesus, as courageous He by the confidence He had in the Father. Of course, in this life we will have trouble, but we may be of good cheer because He has overcome. In Christ we are free to be bold without intimidation!
